Module 1: Getting Started

Module 2: Navigating Australian IT Careers and Professional Environments

As an ACS member, understand IT professionalism and ethics. Use the SFIA Framework to assess your skills and career goals. Engage in interactive quizzes and simulations to develop your practical skills.

Module 3: Exploring Technologies and Career Paths

Stay updated on emerging technologies and their impact on Australia's IT job market. Learn project management fundamentals to boost your value to employers and explore different career paths to identify potential specialisations.
